## Culinary Academy Recognized...Again

The Culinary Arts Academy under the instruction of Chefs David Eichorn and Drew Borenstein, was recently recognized as one of the Top Fifty Culinary and Hospitality Programs in the Nation and a 2017-2018 Career Program of distinction by the National Center for Hospitality Studies.

Comprised of high school and career education programs, the "Elite 50", as named by The NCHS, is a group of Culinary and Hospitality programs from across the country that are reviewed by the National Center for Hospitality Studies as excelling in the areas of Culinary Arts, Baking & Pastry Arts, Restaurant Management and Hospitality Management.

This is the fourth year in a row that the Eastland Culinary Arts Academy has been awarded this honor and the sixth year the Academy was named a program of distinction.

January officially starts competition season for Eastland Students. Students will be competing in local, regional, state and national contest for the remainder of the school year. Eastland students compete through the student organizations SkillsUSA, FCCLA, BPA and FFA. Last year Eastland had 68 students compete in contests at the state level and had several State Level placers and several National Qualifiers!
