Tuesday, May 15, 2018 (*students only*)

Senior Lunch (City BBQ) 12:30 pm at the Fairfield Career Center. Students who need to borrow a graduation gown, will be fitted at this time.

Wednesday, May 16, 2018 (*students only*)

Rehearsal will be at 11:00 am at the Grove City Church of the Nazarene. Students are required to be at rehearsal and must notify the office if they are unable to attend. Students must provide their own transportation to the church, wear their FCC school ID and will be dismissed for the day following rehearsal. Uniforms are not required, but you must follow dress code. No shorts or hats permitted.

Senior Recognition Ceremony will be at 1:00 pm at the Grove City Church of the Nazarene. Students will need to arrive by 12:00 pm. Doors will open for guests at 12:00 pm.

Dress Code for Senior Recognition:

Females: Dress, skirt, blouse, sweater, dress slacks, dress shoes.

NO jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, long gowns/formals, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, low cut tops, etc.

**All students will wear their home school graduation gown for Fairfield's senior recognition ceremony. If a student did not purchase a gown for their home school graduation, there will be extra gowns available to borrow for the ceremony. You will be fitted at the senior lunch 5/15/18.

Junior Shadow/College Visit Day

Ohio School Entry Requirement for Meningococcal Vaccine

All incoming 12th grade students in Ohio schools must have proof that they have the age-appropriate meningococcal vaccines. Students entering 12th grade must have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine, with a minimum interval of 8 weeks between dose one and dose two. If the first dose of meningococcal vaccine was administered after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required. If a student entering 12th grade is 15 years of age or younger, only one dose is required.

You will receive documentation requirements from your student's home school.

GUIDANCE NEWS

College Bound Seniors:

The counselors and lab instructors will talk with seniors in May about articulation credits and final transcript request forms. Seniors should request final transcripts from their home schools.

College Bound Juniors:

Be sure to register by May 4th to retake the ACT on June 9th to improve your score. Use the results from the February 27th ACT given at Fairfield as a guide to help you prepare for the June test. It is recommended you take this test 2 or 3 times to maximize your score. You can register online at www.actstudent.org
