**What is College Credit Plus:**

College Credit Plus (CCP) is Ohio's program for eligible, college-ready students, in grades 7-12, to earn college credit.

**Participation:**

Students interested in taking college credit bearing courses must be "college-ready." Each participating college or university will have their own requirements for determining college readiness and making admissions decisions. There are a variety of ways that a student can participate in a College Credit Plus course. Students may enroll in traditional (face-to-face) courses offered at a participating college or university, on-line courses, courses taught at their career center as part of the normal school day (previously called dual-enrollment), or any combination thereof.

Eastland-Fairfield Career Technical Schools cannot limit a student's participation in College Credit Plus to only courses offered within the district. Students may enroll in multiple postsecondary institutions and take courses from more than one institution of higher education, concurrently. Eligible students should review the courses offered at each college or university.

College Credit Plus courses currently available for eligible students at Eastland Career Center or Fairfield Career Center include.

Eastland Fairfield Career & Technical Schools must offer pre-participation advisement to any students/families interested. In lieu of an in-person advisement session this year, due to the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, we will be sharing a presentation online beginning on or before February 15. **Students must submit an Intent to Participate form to their career center's guidance department by April 1, of the academic year preceding the academic year you wish to participate, or through another means designated by EFCTS. Students who wish to participate in CCP may virtually submit their Intent to Participate as part of their completion of school forms for the subsequent school year, via our district's OneView Portal.**

**Costs:**

Students enrolled at Eastland-Fairfield Career Technical Schools, who are eligible for College Credit Plus courses through a public university or college, may do so at no cost. This includes tuition, books, and fees, but does not include any transportation costs to and from any off-site location where the course may be administered.

There may be a cost to a student should they choose to enroll in a course(s) at a private university or college. This cost may vary from private institution to private institution. Students who are economically disadvantaged will have no cost if attending a course through a private institution. Funding for students from a nonpublic secondary schools may be limited.
